

### NATIONAL MALL

*Between Constitution & Independence Aves. SW*

A splendid green park area extending approximately two miles from the U.S. Capitol to the Washington Monument. Lining either side of the park near the Capitol are 200-year-old American elm trees and several of the Smithsonian Institution museums, National Archives, National Gallery of Art and U.S. Botanic Gardens.

### Arlington History

Located only a few hundred feet across the Potomac River from Washington, D.C., Arlington's proximity to our nation's capital has created a common history, connecting it to Washington, D.C. from the very day the city was first conceived. Originally part of the 10-mile square boundary of the Capital City, Arlington played a central role in the birth of our nation's capital,

and in the formation of our country. Arlington City & County gets its name from the "Arlington House," the Robert E. Lee house located in Arlington National Cemetery. While there are no cities or towns located in Arlington County, Arlington is comprised of 5 distinct and active communities. In addition to the national cemetery, Arlington is also home to the United States Marine Corps Memorial (Iwo Jima), The Pentagon, LBJ Memorial Grove, and a host of other attractions.
